# What is the ALP?

The American Library in Paris (ALP) is an alternative library and study space which is free for ULIP students and only a short walk from the ULIP building.

If you haven't been before just go in, tell them you're a ULIP student and that you would like to join the library and they'll take you through it.

Similarly, if you've been before you'll need to go and ask to renew your membership.

Your membership is all pre paid by ULIP (would normally cost €100!)

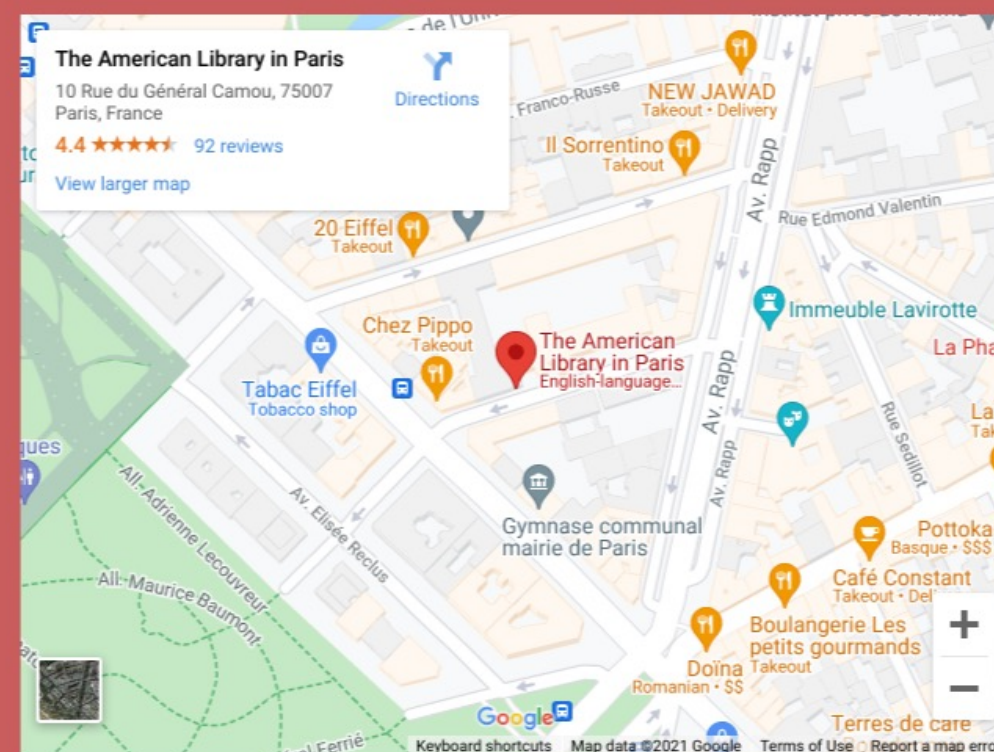
Make sure to bring your mask and pass sanitaire with you to the library!
